Guide for the elaboration of Curriculum Vitae and Motivation Letter

Guide for the elaboration of the Motivation Letter in applying for the PDSH

Candidates must submit a document (letter of motivation) which mentions the following aspects:

- Interest in the enrollment and accomplishment of the PhD in the context of the biographical trajectory
- Brief description of the research topic to be developed
- Relevance and innovation of the research topic to be developed in the area of Human Sexuality

This document must have a maximum of 10 000 characters (without spaces). Bibliographical references (cited in the texts) do not count as characters.

Even though this document is not a "doctoral project", it should demonstrate possible research interests, already evidencing some articulation with the literature in the area. It is, in fact, an opportunity to "present" yourself as a researcher through writing.

Guide for the elaboration of the CV

I. Identification

Name, birthdate, address, phone number, mobile number, e-mail.

II. Academic qualifications

Academic trajectory in Higher Education, indicating: degrees, areas of specialization (if any), final classification(s) and year(s) of completion.

Presentation of supporting documents.

III. Additional training

Training actions considered relevant to the frequency of the Doctoral Program in Human Sexuality with chronological ordering of the information provided and mention of the duration and the promoter of the training.

IV. Professional experience

Presentation of the professional trajectory, chronologically ordered.

V. Participation in intervention/training projects

Specification of the projects, whether they are intervention or training, the duration and type of participation (organizer, facilitator, trainer, team member...).

VI. Publications

Reference to publications indicating authorship/co-authorship, date, title, type of publication (book, journal, book chapter, others ...), edition (publisher, newspaper, magazine) and number of pages.

VII. Participation in scientific meetings with presentation of communications (conferences, seminars, symposiums)

Mention of the authors, year, title of the communication and designation of the scientific meeting and its organizer with chronological ordering of the information.

VIII. Participation in research projects

Specification of the projects (duration, funding) and type of participation (PI, promoter, team member ...)

IX. Others

Any other elements considered, by the candidates, as potentially relevant to the application.
