**SELECTION AND RANKING CRITERIA:**

Selection and ranking based on analysis of CV (and interview if deemed necessary by the jury for

further clarification). The interview will be considered to clarify the weighting of the criteria below. Each candidate will be graded on a scale of minimum 1 and maximum 20. A score of less than 9.5 will result in the application being rejected.

**WEIGHTS** (out of 20 points: 1. relevance of basic training (academic curriculum) in relation to the subject area of the Master's degree (5); 2. course classification obtained in previous training (4); 3. additional training during or after graduation (3); 4. previous research experience (2); 5. professional experience and its relationship with the subject area of the Master's degree (1); 6. dissemination of research or professional practices (1); 7. motivation letter (4).
